

## MILL REEF EDUCATION GRANT: For Antiguan citizens only.

<b>Number of Award(s)</b>	One (1)
<b>Value</b>	Up to US\$16,000 per annum
<b>Maximum Tenure</b>	Three/Five (3/5) years (based on programme and Faculty regulations)
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>The award is available to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Citizens or registered certificate holders of Antigua &amp; Barbuda;</li><li>• New or continuing students pursuing an undergraduate programme who have not already completed a degree programme at any university.</li><li>• The award will be based on high academic performance.</li></ul>
<b>Criteria</b>	<p>DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• UWI's application and acceptance letter</li><li>• CAPE and CXC Scores</li><li>• Secondary school transcript</li><li>• A one page essay on the Applicant's educational goals</li><li>• 2 character reference letters</li><li>• Certified copy of Birth Certificate or Registration Certificate</li></ul> <p>REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or any other stipulation that the UWI/Donor may from time to time require</li><li>• Full time and continuous attendance to classes</li><li>• A Regular course load</li><li>• Sustained good citizenship</li><li>• Express his/her intention to return to Antigua &amp; Barbuda following Graduation.</li><li>• Write a letter to MRF annually on his/her university experience.</li></ul>
<b>Condition</b>	<p>The successful candidate shall <b>NOT</b> be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• the holder or recipient of any other Scholarship or Grant support;</li><li>• the island Scholar, as defined by the Antigua's National Scholarship Committee.</li></ul>
